This message indicates that Microsoft has not tested the compatibility of the drivers and has therefore not approved them. This does not affect the quality of the drivers. A signed driver does not prevent compatibility issues and installation problems.

To continue with the installation, click on **Continue Anyway**.

You can disable this Windows function as follows:

- Click on Start/Control Panel.
- Click on **Performances and Maintenance**.
- Click on System.
- Select the **Hardware** tab.
- Click on **Driver Signing**.
- Enable Ignore Install the software anyway and don't ask for my approval.
