How can I obtain 5.1 outputs with my Muse Pocket on MAC OS X?

Since the Muse Pocket uses the generic operating system drivers, the type of playback may vary depending on your version of MAC OS:

- Stereo playback only was indicated on Muse Pocket packaging, as it was true when the product was released.
- Since Mac OS X **10.3**, 5.1 channel playback is now available (*)
- With Mac OS X **10.3.5**, the audio input can also be selected (either microphone, or line input).
- * The limit is that Mac OS X doesn't allow virtualization (the emulation of a multi-channel output from a stereo source), so you will only obtain 5.1 outputs if you play a 5.1 files. A stereo file, will not provide sound on the center/subwoofer/rear left/rear right channel

You can find 5.1 audio sources from these locations:

- Windows Media 5.1 channel audio files (encoded in Windows Media 9 Professional format) can be played back by **Telestream WMV** for Mac http://www.wm4mac.com/wmv_mac.htm

Since Apple software DVD player is limited to 2 channels, you can use **Video Lan Media Player**, which plays back DVD on 5.1 channels in Mac OS X
