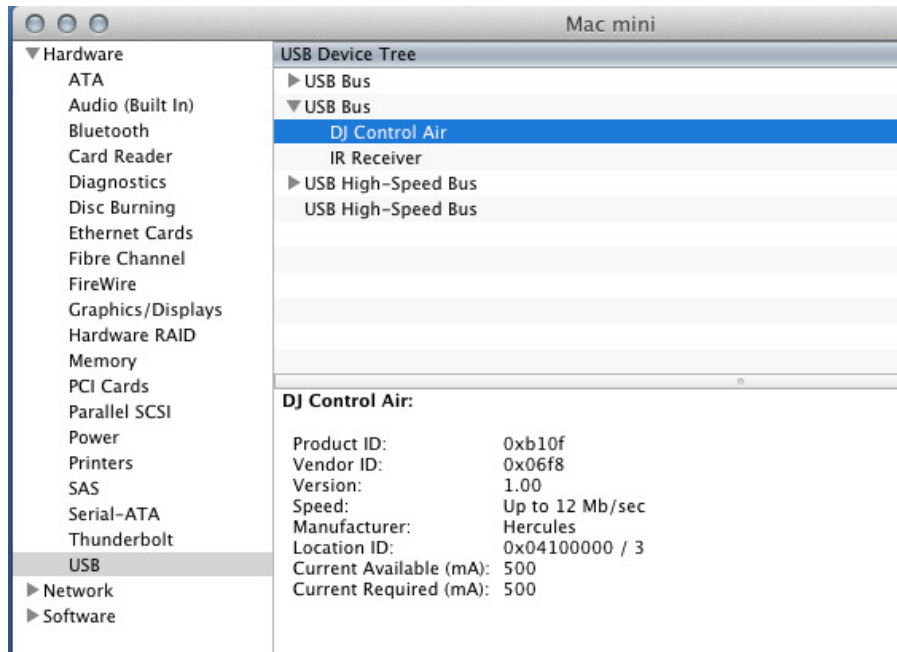
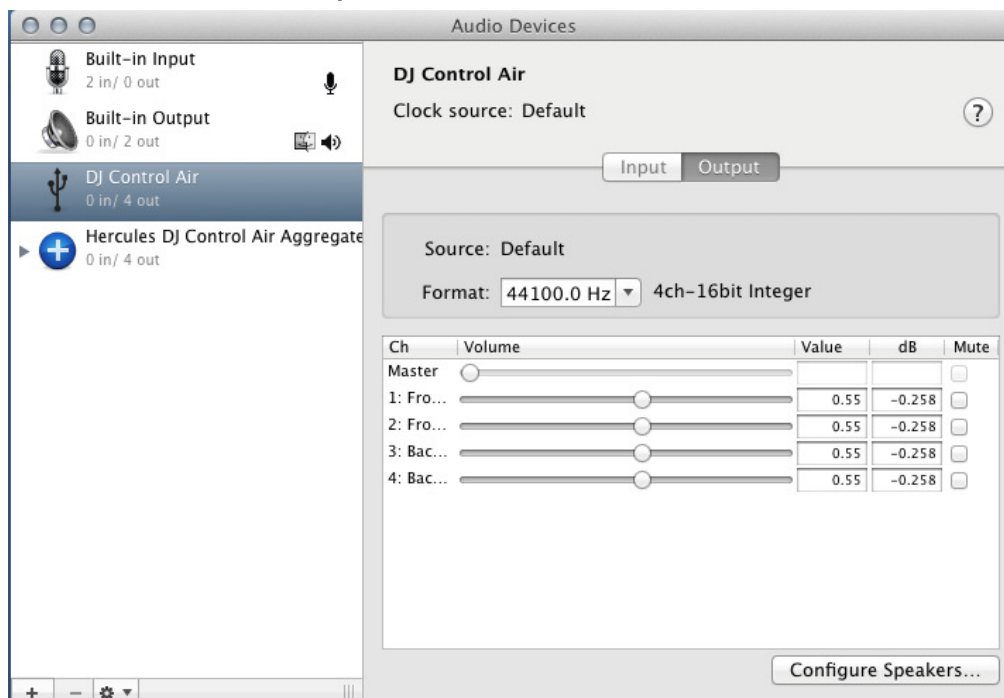


## How can I verify that my DJ Control AIR is correctly installed on my MAC computer?

Once installed, the DJ Control AIR should normally be enumerated by **System Profiler (Application > Utilities)**:



The DJ Control will also be present in **Audio/MIDI SETUP** (also in **Applications > Utilities**):



Both **Hercules DJ Control AIR** and **Hercules DJ Control AIR Aggregate Device** should be present. This is normal and necessary for some DJ software to use all the outputs of the **DJ Control AIR**.

Under **MIDI Devices**, you should notice the **DJ Control AIR** as a device.



The **DJ Console Control Panel**,  should also appear on the desktop

The **ABOUT** tab provides information about the drivers currently installed. If you ever need to contact our technical support, be sure to have this information at hand.
