<u>Virtual DJ - Using and recording external sources</u> (Microphone, Line In/Phono)

The following document explains how to use externals sources with the bundled version of **Virtual DJ LE** or **Virtual DJ Pro Full**.

It is first necessary to configure Virtual DJ accordingly:

- 1- Open the **CONFIG** menu.
- 2- Under **Sound Setup**, apply the following configuration:



Click APPLY to confirm.


Using a Microphone:

1- Turn On the microphone by pressing the **Mic On/Off** button and adjust the microphone level using the **Vol** knob.




This mode is similar to **Talk Over**, which means the microphone signal can be heard over the mix (Output 1-2). You will not be able to hear the microphone in your headphone.

2- If you wish to record the microphone signal, press **Source 1**.







Adjust the microphone level using the **Vol** knob. If necessary, you can also use the **Gain** knob or modify the equalisation using the deck's **Bass**, **Medium** and **Treble** controls.




- **3-** Once you are happy with the configuration, click **REC** to start recording. Click the button again when you are done.
- **4-** Pressing either **Source 1** or **Mic On/Off** will default back to Talk Over mode. Press **Mic On/Off** once more when you want to use Deck A for playing MP3s.

Using Line In/Phono:

1- To start using your external source, press **Source 1**.

Deck A now displays **LineIn 1**, indicating that it is now used as an external source. This also means the signal from this source can be recorded.



- **2-** Adjust the the **Gain** knob or modify the equalisation using the deck's **Bass**, **Medium** and **Treble** controls.
- **3-** Once you are happy with the configuration, click **REC** to start recording. Click the button again when you are done.
- 4- Press Source 1 again when you want to use Deck A for playing MP3s.
